

## *Health and Safety*

For the health and safety of all, it is necessary that students be clean and well groomed.

It is unacceptable to wear clothing which is ill-fitting or inappropriate for school activities, including logos and messages on clothing.

Students who do not have a Sunsafe hat will be restricted to shaded areas during recess and playground breaks.

During sport sessions, students without a hat will be seated in a shady place.

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## *Positive Rewards for Wearing School Uniform*

- Eligibility to be entered in Whole School Prize Draws.
- Positive recognition by administration and teachers.
- Hero Awards and other incentives.
- Knowledge and pride the students have about belonging to the school.

## *Sanctions for Non-Compliance*

The following **will** occur for the students not following the dress code:

- Encouragement to wear the uniform.
- Contact with parent/carer.
- Counselling from a staff member on the benefits of a dress code.
- Assistance/support in obtaining suitable clothing if necessary.
- A pass for an agreed length of time for dress modification.

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**Students not in the dress code may be declined the opportunity to represent the school at official school activities, which may include concerts, excursions and sporting events.**

## **Information for Parents and Students**

## Context

A school dress code:

- Fosters and enhances the public image of the school; and in building class, school and team spirit.
- Ensures students are dressed for specific school activities and encourages equity among students.
- Clearly identifies students when they represent the school, participate in excursions or attend school social functions.

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## Modifications to Dress Code

- Students, who for religious or health reasons may need to modify the school dress code, are required to make an appointment with the Principal to negotiate alternatives.
- Parents are required to substantiate the required modification.
- Staff will be informed of any modifications.
- It is highly desirable that Kindergarten students adhere to the dress code.

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## Dress Code Availability

- School hats can be purchased at the Uniform Shop (Room 18).
- School uniforms can be ordered through the Primary School Parents & Citizens.
- Order forms are available in the front office. The uniform shop is open every Monday and Friday morning between 8:30am and 9:00am.

## Dress Code Inclusions

- Students are to adhere to school colours.
- Tops are to be official school shirts or plain royal blue shirts.
- Skirts, tracksuit pants, jackets, jumpers, jazz pants and shorts should be navy/royal blue.
- Appropriate enclosed footwear must be worn.
- Shoulder-length hair or longer of **all** students is to be tied back and kept clear of students' eyes. Plain headbands and scrunchies may be worn (blue, red or colour of your hair).
- Sunsafeschool hat is compulsory throughout the year.

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## Dress Code Exclusions

*\* Cultural exemptions may apply.*

- Thongs, sandals, slip-ons, ugg boots, rubber boots, high heels and platform shoes.
- **Denim clothing and all leggings.**
- Jewellery with the exception of a watch, ear studs or sleepers, all other piercings must be approved by the Principal.
- Tattoos and nail polish.
- Football boots are only permitted for organised sports sessions with teacher permission.
